What is difference between Master of Arts in Teaching and Master of Education?

The Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) focuses primarily on the advancement of your teaching career. This is the degree most often pursued by people who want hands-on teaching experience and are seeking to work directly with students. The MAT focuses heavily on advanced coursework in a specific subject to hone your expertise. Coursework for the MAT also focuses on pedagogical theory and implementation. Essentially, the MAT will teach you how to be a teacher: methodology, stylistic approach, etc. Oftentimes, the Master of Arts in Teaching consists of hands-on experience that places you in a classroom as a student teacher to practice what you are learning.

Master of Arts in Teaching is an advanced degree geared more towards moving beyond the classroom and into the education system itself. Certified teachers and aspiring teachers can pursue a MAT which allows for a broader range within the educational sphere.

Pathway to Success

The first step is to complete the required Application for Admission. Our unofficial review will give you an idea of about how many of your prior college credits may apply to your degree program and how many additional credits you will need to earn in order to complete your degree. You will receive a thorough assessment report, which will detail what you have accomplished and what is necessary for degree completion.

Initially we will need unofficial copies of all prior academic coursework, as well as a copy of your professional resume. All information submitted will be kept strictly confidential and will be used for school purposes only. Your documents will be will protected to prevent identify

theft. Eventually, we will need official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended.

The Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) is a degree designed for both current and prospective K–12 teachers who are looking to either obtain their initial teaching license or who are looking for additional certification as a means of career advancement inside the classroom.

Earning your MAT provides you with the opportunity to change students' lives inside the classroom. Program concentration/majors include Early Childhood Education, Elementary Education, Secondary Education, and Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESL), Special Education, and Gifted Education.

Teachers with Master of Arts in Teaching degrees usually earn more than teachers who hold only bachelor's degrees. According to a report released in 2012 by the Washington-based Center for American Progress, school districts in the United States spent \$14.8 billion during the 2007-2008 school years to compensate teachers with master's degrees. The additional pay represents a reward for teachers with a master's who are able to provide a better learning environment for students.
